

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF VOLO HELD MARCH 17, 2020.

The Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Volo was called to order at 7:00 P.M. in the Board Room of the Volo Village Hall, Mayor Stephen Henley presiding.

PUBLIC COMMENT – AGENDA ITEMS: None.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: REGULAR MEETING OF MARCH 3, 2020

Trustee Johnson made a motion, seconded by Trustee Heuser, to approve the Minutes of the Regular Meeting of March 3, 2020. On voice vote – all “aye”. MOTION CARRIED.

APPROVAL: ACCOUNTS PAYABLE – MARCH 17, 2020

Trustee Johnson made a motion, seconded by Trustee Northam, to authorize payment of the bills as listed in the Treasurer’s Report for March 17, 2020. Roll Call: Trustees Wagner, Porter, Johnson, Heuser, Buttita, Northam – all “aye”. MOTION CARRIED.

ORDINANCE NO. O-20-04: EMERGENCY POWERS ORDINANCE

Trustee Johnson made a motion, seconded by Trustee Porter, to approve Ordinance No. O-20-04, amending the Village Code to allow the Mayor to exercise emergency powers in the event that a disaster is declared affecting the Village. Roll Call: Trustees Porter, Johnson, Heuser, Buttita, Northam, Wagner – all “aye”. MOTION CARRIED.

PUBLIC COMMENT: None.

TRUSTEE REPORTS: Trustee Wagner noted that ICSC has postponed RECon due to COVID-19. Trustee Porter noted that the blood drive scheduled for April 4th has been cancelled, also due to COVID-19.

MAYOR’S REPORT: Mayor Henley provided a brief update on his meetings with the Governor’s Office and IDOT in Springfield on March 4th.
