New Code Enforcement Program Announced Overnight Parking Enforcement to Begin in November

In November, the Village will begin implementing a new code enforcement program.

Historically, the Village's enforcement efforts have been reactive — in response to service requests for code-related matters.

As the Village has grown, code-related service requests have increased in number and frequency, indicating the need for proactive enforcement.

The Village has also received requests for proactive code enforcement from residents and homeowners associations who feel it is important to maintaining property values and the visual aesthetic of the community.

The goal of the Village's code enforcement program is to ensure compliance with and address violations of various regulations, including:

- Overnight Parking
- Boat, Trailer, and RV Storage
- Garbage Cart Storage
- Property Maintenance; including Grass and Weeds
- Building Permit Requirements
- Zoning / Use Restrictions

It will take 6–9 months to fully implement the new program.

Overnight Parking Enforcement

On November 1st, the Village will begin nightly enforcement of its overnight parking regulations.

Parking is prohibited on all Village streets between 2:00 AM and 6:00 AM. Vehicles found parked in violation of this ordinance will be ticketed (\$25 fine, per occurrence).

No Overnight Parking signs (SEE BELOW) are posted at the entrance(s) to each subdivision.



The Village will contract for overnight parking enforcement with the Wauconda Police Department.

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Garbage Pick-Up Delayed

Garbage pick-up will be delayed one day during the week of September 7th due to Labor Day.

There will be no garbage or recycling pick-up on Monday, September 7th. Service will take place one day later.

Parking Regulations

Pursuant to Village Ordinance, parking is prohibited on all Village streets between 2:00 AM and 6:00 AM.

Parking of vehicles across the sidewalk or blocking driveways and mailboxes is also prohibited.

Vehicles found in violation of these ordinances may be ticketed. The minimum fine is \$50.

Garbage & Recycling Carts

Pursuant to Village Ordinance (O-17-08), garbage/recycling carts may only be placed at the curb between 4:00 PM on Sunday and 10:00 PM on Monday.

If stored outside, carts may only be kept in side or rear yards and must be screened from view of the street.

Homeowner Associations (HOAs) may have additional requirements.

Smoke Detectors

Daylight Savings Time ends Sunday, November 1st at 2:00 AM.

Fox Lake and Wauconda Fire encourage residents to change the batteries in their smoke detectors when they change their clocks.

It is estimated that while 90% of households have smoke detectors, one-third have dead or missing batteries.

Code Enforcement

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Overnight Parking Waiver

Individuals can request a waiver to park a passenger vehicle on the street overnight. Waivers are issued by vehicle (license plate) and valid for one (1) night. A maximum of twelve (12) waivers will be issued to a vehicle in a year. A waiver must be requested before parking a vehicle on the street overnight.

Overnight Parking Permit

Residents may also purchase a permit to park a passenger vehicle on the street overnight. The fee is \$100 per month, or portion thereof, payable in advance. Permits are issued by vehicle (license plate) and non-transferrable. Only passenger vehicles registered to a residential address in the Village are eligible for an overnight parking permit.

Snow Parking Regulations

In the event of a snowfall of two (2") or more inches, overnight parking waivers and overnight parking permits are not valid. Parking is prohibited on all streets until snow removal operations are complete. Vehicles found parked in violation of this ordinance will be ticketed (\$200 fine) and subject to towing.

The overnight parking permit application will be available October 1st on the Village's website at www.villageofvolo.com/parking. Waivers can be requested online (www.villageofvolo.com/parking) or by calling the Village Hall.

50/50 Tree Program

The 50/50 Tree Program is a cost-sharing program encouraging residents to plant new trees on their property.

- Residents are reimbursed 50% of the cost of a single new tree, excluding sales tax, delivery, and installation, not to exceed \$200.
- The tree must be planted in the front yard of the home or the parkway.
- Program funds are disbursed as a reimbursement after the purchase and installation of a new tree.
- Each household may participate in the program once every other year.
